The Village of Greenport will accept sealed bids only at the Office of the Village Clerk, Greenport Village Hall, 236 Third Street, Greenport, New York 11944, from 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 22, 2018 until 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 5, 2018; at which time all timely received sealed bids will be opened. Bids received after that time will be considered noncompliant and rejected.

Bids must be filed in accordance with the specifications of the Village of Greenport and Municipal Law Section 103. Bids should indicate on the outside of the sealed envelope "Bid for Work on Village Trees – March 2018". Bids must be either hand-delivered to the Village Hall as indicated or sent by overnight mail to be received no later than 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 5, 2018.

The Village of Greenport reserves the right to reject all bids or to waive any irregularity in a bid and further reserves the right to accept the lowest responding bid that is deemed to be in the best interest of the Village of Greenport.

The work performed under this contract is subject to the prevailing wage requirements of the New York State Labor Law.
