PORT is looking to put up an additional canopy similar to what we currently have on our property at 104 Third Street. This canopy is much smaller and not attached to the building.

There will be no change in the CO. There will be no change in the use, occupancy or tenancy space. It will cover a small dining area that is already in use. We are simply replacing a Sun-Sail and umbrellas with something safer and more comfortable.

When we put up the existing awning 5 years ago; we were issued a stop-work order on the project. This was because Mills and Company attached the canopy to the reverse gable without including it in the proposal. We were advised to bring this matter to the planning board and the issue was quickly rectified and work was resumed. This current project will be freestanding and not be attached to the building. Our proposed design and engineering report accommodate all codes applicable in the Village of Greenport. Attached you will find the design criteria, drawings, materials and the location.

I do not believe this needs to go in front of the planning board; but rather, the building inspector can oversee this project, as it makes no significant change to our business or property.





Also complies with NY State 2020, Chapter 16, Section BC 1601 Structural Design.

All Awning/Canopy frames are designed in accordance with section 1608.0 of the New York State Building Code 2020 Chapter 16 to withstand a 25 lb/sq ft snow load. Snow loading is per figure 1608.2 and is classified as "Ground Snow Loads" which is based on the geographical location.
