

Village Early Mail Ballot Application

Please print clearly. See detailed instructions.

To receive an early mail ballot: **In-Person:** Application must be delivered to the village clerk's office not later than the day before the election. *Election Law § 15-119(7).* **By Mail:** Application must be received by the village clerk's office not later than the 7th day before the election. *Election Law § 15-119(7).*

The ballot itself must be received by the village clerk's office no later than the close of polls on Election Day in order to be canvassed. *Election Law § 15-119(10).*

Instructions:

Who may apply for an early mail ballot?

Each person must apply for themselves. It is a felony to make a false statement in an application for an early mail ballot, to attempt to cast an illegal ballot, or to help anyone to cast an illegal ballot.

Information for military and overseas voters:

If you are applying for an early mail ballot because you or your family are in the military or because you currently reside overseas, do not use this application. You are entitled to special legal provisions if you apply using the Federal Postcard Application (FPCA). Where and when to return your application:

Applications for an early mail ballot that will be delivered in-person at the Village Clerk's Office to the voter or an agent of the voter must be received not later than one day before the election. Applications for a ballot to be delivered by mail to the voter must be received at the Village Clerk's office no later than seven days before the election.

Options available to you if you have an illness or disability:

You may sign the early mail ballot application yourself, or you may make your mark and have your mark witnessed in the spaces provided on the bottom of the application. Please note that a power of attorney or printed name stamp is not allowed for any voting purpose.

When your ballot will be sent:

Your early mail ballot materials will be sent to you at least six days before the election in which you are eligible to vote. If applicant or agent delivers the application to the Village Clerk in person after the seventh day before the Village election and not later than the day before the election, the Village Clerk shall delivery such early mail ballots for those applicants who he/she determines are qualified to make such applications and to receive such ballots to such applicants or the agents named in the applications when such applicants or agents appear in the Village Clerk's office.
