

GREENPORT VILLAGE 2023 ELECTION INFORMATION

January 19, 2023

Election Date: March 21, 2023
Voting Place: Third Street Fire Station, Greenport
Voting Times: 6 a.m. until 9 p.m.

Candidates:

Candidates must be nominated on an Independent Nominating Petition that is signed by registered voters who reside in the Village of Greenport. Petition signers may only sign petitions for two candidates for trustee and one candidate for mayor. Subsequent signatures by an individual will be invalid. Petitions must be filed at the Office of the Village Clerk from February 7, 2023 to February 14, 2023.

Voter Eligibility:

A person must be a resident of the Village of Greenport and registered to vote with either the Board of Elections of Suffolk County or the Village of Greenport in order to vote. A person that is registered to vote at a location that is outside of the Village of Greenport is not eligible to vote.
