## LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Village of Greenport ("Village"), Suffolk County, New York, effective at 12:00pm on December 22, 2023.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by recent damage to the Village's primary wastewater collection system piping and the consequent environmental and public health concerns resulting from new or repeated damage to the Village's water pollution control system and facilities.

Such conditions threaten or imperil ecological and environmental resources in and around the Village of Greenport and the public safety of the citizens of the Village.

The State of Emergency shall be applicable to the entire Village and to Village sewer facilities extending beyond the boundaries of the Village.

This State of Emergency shall remain in effect for a period of 30 days until rescinded by a subsequent order.

As Chief Executive of the Village of Greenport, I have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law, Article 2-B, to preserve the public safety and hereby render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct all Village departments to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.
